Cascade is 1/2 mile on the left.

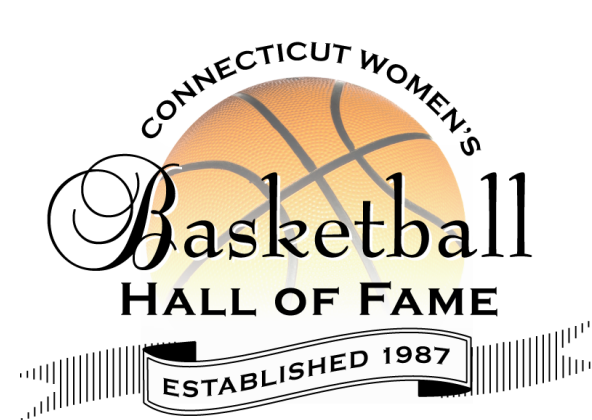
From Hartford via I-91
